* If it is not possible to apply online during the designated period, applicants may submit their application materials well in advance of the on-line application period by post or in person.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

1. A non-Korean national whose parents are BOTH non-Korean nationals.

- Anyone who has acquired foreign citizenship by changing his/her nationality is not eligible.
- A Korean citizen who is a dual national is not considered a non-Korean national
- 2. Master's and Master's-Doctoral Joint Degree Program Applicants: Holder of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university (or is expected to receive a Bachelor's degree before the end of the admission period of the term the applicant is applying to)
- 3. Doctoral Program Applicants: A holder of a Master's degree from an accredited college or university (or is expected to receive a Master's degree before the end of the admission period of the term the applicant is applying to)

3. Admissions Criteria

Admissions decisions are based on the candidate's academic achievements and potential, as well as his or her personal accomplishments.
