

# GRADUATE ADMISSIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

## (SPRING 2012)

### 1. Admissions Timeline

Step	Deadline
1. On-line Application	September 20 (Tuesday) - November 18 (Friday), 2011
2. Submission of Documents (by post or in person)	September 20 (Tuesday) - November 18 (Friday), 2011
3. Announcement of Admissions Decision	December 29 (Thursday), 2011

※ If it is not possible to apply online during the designated period, applicants may submit their application materials well in advance of the on-line application period by post or in person.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

1. A non-Korean national whose parents are BOTH non-Korean nationals.
  - Anyone who has acquired foreign citizenship by changing his/her nationality is not eligible.
  - A Korean citizen who is a dual national is not considered a non-Korean national
2. Master's and Master's-Doctoral Joint Degree Program Applicants: Holder of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university (or is expected to receive a Bachelor's degree before the end of the admission period of the term the applicant is applying to)
3. Doctoral Program Applicants: A holder of a Master's degree from an accredited college or university (or is expected to receive a Master's degree before the end of the admission period of the term the applicant is applying to)

### 3. Admissions Criteria

Admissions decisions are based on the candidate's academic achievements and potential, as well as his or her personal accomplishments.

### 4. Scholarship for International Students
