2012- 2013 Short-Term Student Exchange Program

YSEP will accept approximately 35 to 40 international students from Tokyo Tech partner universities who have previously established an exchange agreement with our institution. There are 2 types of YSEPs: YSEP Focused on Research (YFR, 1 year) and YSEP for Experiencing Japan (YEJ, 6 months).

YFR is from September 2012 to August 2013.

YFR is open to 4th Year Undergraduate students & 1st Year Master students.

YEJ starts in September 2012 or in March 2013.

YEJ is open to students who have completed at least two and half years of undergraduate study.

Application Deadlines:

YFR Yearlong program (September 2012 start date) Deadline: <u>the end of February 2012</u> (Japan Standard Time).

YEJ Autumn Semester (September 2012 start date) Deadline: <u>the end of February 2012 (Japan</u> Standard Time).

YEJ Spring Semester (March 2013 start date) Deadline: <u>15th of August 2012 (Japan Standard</u> Time).

Application materials for applicants who expect to start their studies at Tokyo Tech as ACAP students between April 2012 and July 2012 who are also applying for JASSO scholarships must arrive at Tokyo Tech by airmail no later than December 27, 2011 (Japan Standard Time). Applicants who are expected to start their studies at Tokyo Tech between August 2012 and March 2013 who are also applying for JASSO scholarships, are requested to submit all application materials no later than the end of February 2012. For applicants who are not applying for JASSO scholarships, the application materials should arrive at Tokyo Tech by the 20th of the month which is more than three months (90 days) prior to the desired start date.
