- The nationality of parents of an applicant should be non-Korean.
- Overseas Koreans are eligible if they completed courses equivalent to Korean secondary, tertiary education
- Applicants with no nationality or dual citizenship of Korean are not eligible for International student admission.
- * No certificate for language skills are required, but applicants for some departments are required to have certain level of language skills as specified below.

4. Admission Criteria

- **A.** Admission decisions are based on document screening including candidate's academic achievements, personal accomplishments, and language proficiency. Depending on policy of department/major, written examination, interview, and practical/performance test shall be required.
- **B.** For document screening, several important assessing factors academic performance such as Grade Point Average (GPA), level of completed courses, study plan, personal statement, etc shall take into consideration.
- C. Procedure of Admissions
 - 1) Primary choice rounding comes first, and secondary choice follows next.

 Secondary choice screening by the alternate choice departments is only for unsuccessful applicants in the previous review.
 - 2) Regardless a degree program, applicant who has highest total score shall be selected.
 - 3) If one of admission criteria is failed, applicant will not get admission from CNU.

5. Application Fee

The application fee of 60,000 KRW will be included in your first semester tuition bill.

7. Additional Notes

- **A.** Change of department is not allowed after completing the application.
- **B.** Applicants who have submitted verification of expected graduation from university must submit official verification of graduation within **15 days** of admission to the Office of International Affairs at CNU.
- **C.** Students found to have forged or illegally changed application documents may have their admission to CNU revoked.
- **D.** If applicants write their address and telephone number incorrectly, or they are out of contact, they are responsible for all the inconveniences resulting from those mistakes.
- E. Submitted documents and application fees will neither be returned nor refunded. (Original certificate of graduation is returned after the application process is completed.)
- **F.** CNU does not reveal the evaluation records of each application process in any circumstance.
- **G.** Matters that are not included in this guide shall proceed according to the guidelines of CNU Admissions Management Committee.

A. Academic Performance Scholarships

B. Global Scholarships

- 1) Eligibility: Up to 10% of new graduate students
- 2) Minimum Qualifications: Instructors or researchers in colleges or their equivalent research institutes
- 3) Required Documents: Scholarship application form, proof of employment, and Letter of Recommendation for Global Scholarship written by a future academic advisor
- 4) How to apply: Via e-mail (internia@jnu.ac.kr) by Oct. 26, 2012
- 5) Benefits: Exemption from fees and tuition (entrance fees, tuition, school support fees) within four-semester time limit
- 6) Conditions of Keeping the Scholarship: GPA 4.0 or above in the previous semester

C. Research Scholarships

- 1) Qualifications:
- a) Applicants who are recommended as research assistants by their academic advisors
- b) Applicants who pass the research scholarship screening procedures
- 2) Required Documents: Scholarship application form, proof of employment, and Letter of Recommendation for Global Scholarship written by a future academic advisor
- 3) How to Apply: Via e-mail (exchangeia2@jnu.ac.kr) by Oct. 26, 2012
- 4) Benefits: Full scholarship in the first semester plus the financial support by their academic advisors

D. S-TOPIK Scholarships

- 1) How to Apply: Via e-mail (exchangeia@jnu.ac.kr) and submit the S-TOPIK Certificate (Original copy) to the Office of International Affairs by Oct. 26, 2012
- 2) Benefits
- S-TOPIK Level 6: Full Scholarship in the first semester and Tuition exemption from the second semester S-TOPIK Level 5: Full Scholarship in the first semester
 - * Students who get level 6 on S-TOPIK at CNU are exempted from tuition from the next semester.
- E. Recipients of home country governmental scholarship are given a partial tuition waiver.
- F. New students will get housing support of self-catering dormitory fees (about US\$ 650) on the first semester.
 - 1) How to Apply: apply for dorm, pay the dorm fee in advance, get health insurance upon arrival, and dormitory supporting fee shall be reimbursed toward the end of semester.
 - * Obtaining health insurance is mandatory for all international students.
 - 2) Conditions: Health Insurance Obtainer
 - * Available to apply upon arrival at CNU costs approximately \$130 per year
