Undergraduate Transfer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foreigners whose parents are not Koreans or Foreigners who graduated from elementary, middle school, high school and college outside Korea regardless of parents' nationality. • Foreigners who completed at least 1-year (2 semesters) or 2-year (4 semesters) course in Korea or from other universities abroad with at least 35 or 70 units. ※ Students who graduated from colleges without the accrediting system cannot apply. • Foreigners who graduated from colleges in Korea or other colleges abroad (including students who are expected to graduate on February of 2015) with at least 70 units/credits. ※ Students who graduated from colleges without the accrediting system cannot apply. • Applicants can select their major regardless of their former university major. The units obtained from the applicant's former university would be evaluated and credited upon the decision of the department head. • Application is limited whom have a disciplinary punishment from former university. • Registered CBNU students (current students, temporarily-withdrawn students, expelled students) cannot apply.

06 Notice for Required Documents

- Certificate of Transcript and Diploma Verification accredited by one of the following institutions : an Original Copy

- If an issue of the verification form is not yet complete at the time of applying, applicants must submit copies of transcript/diploma and proof of application along with other required documents.
- Applicants must submit the original transcripts/diplomas and verification form (approved by the above institutions only) by Nov.28th, 2014. Failure to do so will cause your admission cancelled.
- **Original book of Household Register** : an Original Copy and a Translation
 - ▶ It must contain up-to-date information of all family member records of 6 months from the application date at least.
 - ▶ If the Household Register does not contain the records of all family members, you must submit a Certificate of Relationship of your family which can be obtained from the local police office.
 - ▶ If you are currently enrolled in a university and your name is not on the Household Register of your family, you need to get the Household Register from the university and submit it additionally.
- **Important Notice for Chinese Applicants when submitting Certificate of Balance**
 - ▶ Submit after the Admission Announcement on Jun 23th, 2014
 - ▶ It must show that the owner has deposited USD \$12,000 or more
(The issue date should Dec 30th, 2014 and the money should be frozen until Feb 28th, 2015)
 - ▶ The deposit date, issuance date and period of frozen account must be included.
 - ▶ Please include the phone number of the Bank's office in charge at the bottom of the page.
