

Eligibility

- MS and MS-Ph.D. Integrated Program applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree before beginning graduate study. Students in their final year of undergraduate study may be admitted on the condition that their bachelor's degrees are awarded before they enroll at POSTECH.
- Ph.D. applicants must have earned a master's degree before enrolling at POSTECH. Students in their final year of graduate study for MS may be admitted on the condition that their master's degrees are awarded before they enroll at POSTECH.

Admissions Procedures

Complete Online Application \Rightarrow Submit Required Documents \Rightarrow Receive Confirmation of Submission \Rightarrow Notified of Admissions Decision

Application Materials

Required Documents

- (1) Application Form
 - Applicants must fill out the online application.
 - Application fee: US\$50 or 80,000 KRW
 - Payment must be made online via credit card.
 - Payment can be waived for applicants from POSTECH's partner universities.
- (2) Checklist of Documents*
- (3) Personal Statement and Research Plan*/**
- (4) Official Transcript(s)
 - From all undergraduate and graduate institutions you attended.
 - Transcript(s) issued by the registrar of the institution attended, bearing the original raised or colored seal of the institution and the signature of the institution's registrar or academic official.

(5) Degree Certificate(s)

- From all undergraduate and graduate institutions from which you received degrees.
- Applicants who expect to earn a degree can submit an enrollment certificate.
- Applicants who have graduated from a university in China must additionally submit a "Certificate" issued at the "China Academic Degrees & Graduate Education Development Center".

(6) Recommendation Letters*

- From two recommenders (academic faculty preferred).
- Must be emailed directly by each recommender or be enclosed in a sealed envelope.

(7) Score Report of English Proficiency Test

- Every applicant whose native language is not English must demonstrate English language proficiency.
- Applicants must meet one of the English Proficiency Test minimum score requirements: TOEFL PBT 550, TOEFL CBT 213, TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6.0, TOEIC 800, TEPS 680 or higher.
- TOEFL Score Report issued by ETS can be sent to POSTECH Graduate Admissions and Student Affairs. POSTECH's institution code for ETS is 0329.

- TOEFL ITP only organized by POSTECH is accepted.
- Proof of Instruction Language*** can be substituted for the English Proficiency Test.
- Applicants who have graduated from a university in Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, Great Britain, and the United States are exempt from the English Proficiency Test.
- (8) Curriculum Vitae (Free style personal resume)**
- (9) Signed Consent Form */**

Optional Documents

- (10) Copy of Passport**
 - Applicants who do not hold a passport can submit it later.
- (11) List of Honors and Awards***
 - If you have received any honors, awards, or fellowships during your undergraduate or graduate studies, or any academic certificates and test reports, please list them in order of importance.
- (12) Degree Theses
 - * Applicants can download the forms from the POSTECH website (http://admission.postech.ac.kr/mainUsen.do).
 - ** Applicants can submit the form(s) electronically.
 - *** Proof of Instruction Language means that applicants have taken courses provided in English. Also, it must include the institution's seal.

Note

- Applicants must submit the required documents by mail to the Office of Graduate Admissions and Student Affairs by the admissions deadline. Applications submitted after admissions deadline will not be reviewed.
- POSTECH reserves the right to revoke an offer of admission or terminate a student's registration, should it be discovered later that: a false statement has been made; a false document has been provided; documentation has been altered; or if there has been an omission of significant information.
- All documents must be original and issued by the institution that
 bears the actual signature of the registrar in ink and its own seal.
 All official academic records must be issued in the original
 language and accompanied by English translation prepared by the
 issuing institution.

Financial Aid

Fellowships

POSTECH Fellowship for Excellent International Students

Awarded to applicants who are recommended by the president of their home universities or by the Korean ambassador/consul in their home countries.

SK hynix Fellowship (US\$9,500/year)

Awarded to students including newly incoming students who are interested in conducting semiconductor-related research and/or pursuing a career in the field of semiconductor after graduation.

POSCO Asia Fellowship

(MS/MS-Ph.D. Integrated Program): US\$13,000/year, Ph.D.: US\$16,000/year)

Awarded to applicants from Asian countries for Fall 2014 Admissions.

POSCO Africa Fellowship

(MS/MS-Ph.D. Integrated Program): US\$13,000/year, Ph.D.: US\$16,000/year)

Awarded to applicants from Zimbabwe and Democratic Republic of the Congo for Fall 2014 Admissions.

Korean Government Scholarship Program (US\$19,000/year)

The Korean Government Scholarship Program is designed to support international students pursuing higher education in Korea, with the aim of promoting international exchange in education, as well as mutual friendship amongst the participating countries. POSTECH is one of the designated universities in Korea, and international applicants can only apply from February to March every year.

Assistantships

POSTECH Teaching or Research Assistantship

Available to graduate students who are selected as teaching or research assistants.

POSTECH Administrative Staff Assistantship

Available to graduate students who are selected as administrative staff assistants.

Other Grants

POSTECH Settlement Allowance for New International Students (US\$2,800)

Awarded as a one-time grant given to all incoming international graduate students during the first semester of enrollment at POSTECH.

Institutional Loan

Available to graduate students who have financial difficulties in continuing their graduate study.



^{**} This is established to reduce the financial burden on students in case of illness or injury. Students enrolled in the plan can receive 80% of medical expenses in reimbursement up to the maximum of 1,000,000 KRW per semester.


