	be rented at the laundry shop at POSTECH. Upon the student's arrival, the assigned buddy will meet the student on campus and guide him or her to their assigned dormitory.
Check-out Period	Check-out date will be the next day from the final exam period (mid-June, 2016). The exact date will be decided once the academic calendar for year 2016 is announced. If the student has to extend their stay at POSTECH due to participating in lab research or examinations, he or she may do so upon their advising professor's approval.
