

Hiroshima University Summer Program
"Introduction to Advanced and Integrated Science"
1st August – 7th August, 2016

It is our great pleasure to inform you that Hiroshima University Graduate School of Science will offer the Summer Program "Introduction to Advanced and Integrated Science" for Asian and Russian students and in order to promote mutual exchange between Hiroshima University and Asian and Russian Universities. We would be grateful if you could recommend your student who is interested in attending the program.

1. Schedule: 1st August - 7th August, 2016 (Arrival on 31st July and Departure on 8th August)
2. Eligibility:
 - (1) Students must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program in the field of natural sciences (Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Earth Science, or Mathematics).
 - (2) Students must have a good academic record (GPA: above 2.3 or equivalent). *1
 - (3) Students must have sufficient English proficiency to be able to comprehend classes, give presentations, and write reports. *2
 - (4) Tuition fee will be exempted.
 - (5) Every participant has to pay for round trip airfare to Hiroshima University and other costs not including the program (e.g. transportation for personal mobility, hospital care, or any personal matters). Every student is required to buy a traveler's insurance.
 - (6) For the students from each university, who are eligible to above requirements will be able to receive the scholarship, JPY 50,000, provided by the Graduate School of Science, Hiroshima University. The scholarship will cover the program related costs; namely accommodation, transportation for study inside Hiroshima, materials and so on.
3. Application Procedure:
 - (1) Submit your completed application form to the office in charge of this program at your institution by April 30, 2016.
 - (2) The office in charge of this program in your university selects **one** excellent student by above requirements and recommends those four applicants to the Hiroshima University Graduate School of Science with their application forms.
 - (3) The Hiroshima University Graduate School of Science examines applicants' eligibilities by the application forms and informs the results to the office at your institution with invitation letters.
4. Each of a completed student will receive a certificate and a transcript issued by the Hiroshima University Graduate School of Science.
