ABOUT MISSOURI S&T



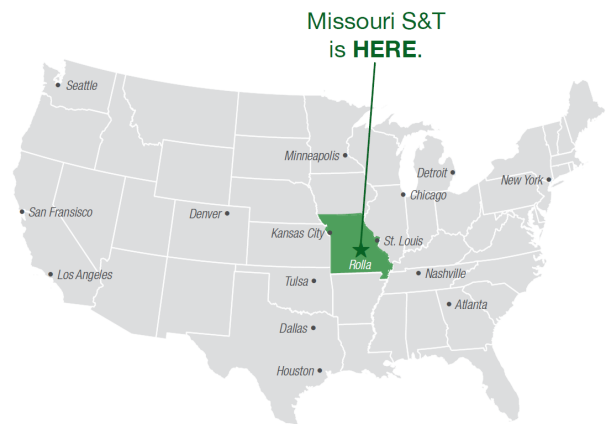
Missouri S&T is one of the nation's top technological research universities with a world-wide reputation for academic excellence.

Missouri S&T's 284-acre campus is in the center of the town of Rolla, a community of about 20,000 in the heart of the Missouri Ozarks.
