<b>Term dates for the academic year:</b>	The 1 <sup>st</sup> Semester: 1 <sup>st</sup> week of August – 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of December The 2 <sup>nd</sup> Semester: 1 <sup>st</sup> week of January - 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of May Summer Session: 1 <sup>st</sup> week of June – 4 <sup>th</sup> week of July
<b>Due date of application:</b>	The 1 <sup>st</sup> semester entry: 10 <sup>th</sup> June The 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester entry: 10 <sup>th</sup> November Summer semester entry: 10 <sup>th</sup> April
<b>Exams:</b>	The 1 <sup>st</sup> semester: Mid-term - 4 <sup>th</sup> week of September / Final - 4 <sup>th</sup> week of November - 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of December The 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester: Mid-term - 4 <sup>th</sup> week of February to 1 <sup>st</sup> week of March / Final - 2 <sup>nd</sup> to 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of May
<b>Marks Transmission:</b>	Takes about a month after the end of each semester
